


The Bus Terminal of Maebashi Station north exit



Mt.Akagi is a collective term for Kurobisan, the main crest and other mountains such as Komagatake, Jizotake, Arayama, Mt.Nabewari, Suzugatake and Mt.Choshichiro, Each mountain is unique and attractive.



A crater lake formed by volcanic activities of Mt.Choshichiro. It is located 1,470 meters above sea level, in the southeast of Onuma. The perimeter is about 1 km and there is a path along it which takes 30 to 40 min on foot. The tranquil appearance is alluring.



Ono(Onuma)

A crater lake at 1,345 meter elevation, in the peak area of Mt. Akagi. You can enjoy smelt fishing from a boat in fall and on the frozen lake in winter.



Senbonzakura (One Thousand Cherry Trees) of Southern Akagi

A notable spot of cherry trees in Maebashi City, which is designated as one of "Japan's Top 100 Cherry Blossom Viewing Sites"





Maebashi City Museum of Literature

At this facility, exhibits information materials of Sakutaro Hagiwara, the poet who made a huge contribution to the history of modern-style poetry and other poets who are associated with Maebashi City. There are lots of stelas of poems on the green path along the Hirosegawa river.
